He proceeded to tell us to make it quick.

The room was dark, but we made our way to Robert's bed, where we could barely see all the tubes and instruments. We said his name a few times and he woke up and told us he had a brain aneurism and was in a lot of pain. We told him we couldn't stay and he asked for prayer, I anointed his head which was extremely hot and sweaty. Dan and I offered prayer, and while we were praying we felt his whole body shake. Dan later told me he felt a surge of energy go through his arms and into Roberts. We left right away as instructed by the doctor. As we opened the door to the room, the young lady I saw in the waiting room talking to the doctor, had tears in her eyes and a look of fear on her face. I told her we had prayed and she said that was her Dad. We walked down the hallway and as we stepped into the elevator the Lord spoke to me and said, "*Go tell that young man in the waiting room that the doctor may have bad news, but I the Lord have good news*" so I did and we left.

That was on a Wednesday evening, and on Friday I felt such an urgency in my spirit to go back up to the hospital to see this man again that I could hardly wait to finish work. When I arrived at the hospital I checked to find his room # again and when I said his name two ladies came over and asked who I was. They introduced themselves as his sister and his other daughter. They told me I needed to go see him right away. When I got to his room he was sitting up in bed watching TV with absolutely no machines, no tubes, nothing. I introduced myself because he was not able to see us the first time we were there. He told me he had received a miracle, that he had had a double brain aneurism and that was why he was rushed in to the hospital. Now, they cannot find any sign of it, he told me how he had felt the surge that Dan had explained, and then he said the Lord told him he was going to be okay.

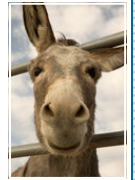

## The Voice of Issachar . . . Simply Nunn-Sense (a.k.a. Thomas Royal Nunn)



On Mount Zion there is no water. They depended on the Gihon Spring, which was at the base of the hill. David took the city by sending his men up the tunnel that went from the spring to the citadel.

The word 'zion' means 'dry', 'parched', 'arid'. In Hebrew there is a synonym for this word. It is 'horeb'. Horeb also means 'dry', 'parched', 'arid'. This was the name of the district in which the Mountain of God was found. It is also the place where the water was brought out of the rock (Ex. 17:6).

Horeb was a place where the only water that Israel had was that provided by the Lord. Horeb and Zion are corresponding places: both are without water. Horeb is also the alternate name of Mount Sinai (Ex. 3:1) and is the preferred name in Deuteronomy..

Water sometimes is a symbol of the Holy Spirit (Isa. 44:3; Jer. 2:13). The rock in Horeb represents Christ (1Cor. 10:4). The water flowing from the Rock in Horeb is the Spirit flowing from Christ.

And in Horeb the Lord made a Covenant with His People (Deut. 5:2). Zion and Horeb are essentially one and the same. Zion is that place or condition where the only Spirit we receive is that from the Lord. And Zion is the place of the Covenant of God.

He is looking for a People who will utterly surrender to Him so that He is their will, their desire, their motivation, their intelligence, their wisdom, their reason for being. He is looking for Galatians 2:20 fleshed out in His People, as it was fleshed out in Jesus.

In this last day God has chosen Independence as a central place for this Community of His Zion. This name, Independence, is no accident. *That the Church may stand independent above all other creatures beneath the celestial world (D&C 77:3d)* speaks of this Communion between the Lord and His People.

And as His People respond He will have such communities throughout the world.

**Aileen Nicole Coleman-Mullen** (born January 3, 1964) is an award-winning singer, songwriter, and choreographer. She was born and raised in Cincinnati, Ohio. She recorded her first solo album, *Don't Let Me Go*, in 1991 with the independent label Frontline Records. Mullen continued her singing-songwriting-choreography career in the 1990's, singing backup for Michael W. Smith and the Newsboys, writing for Jaci Velasquez, and working as a dancer/choreographer with Amy Grant. She also provided backup vocals for the music video at the end of the VeggieTales program, *Larry-Boy and the Fib from Outer Space!* and the opening of the VeggieTales presentation, *Larry-Boy and the Rumor Weed*. She was signed to Word Records in 1998 by VP of A&R Brent Bourgeois. Her fourth album, *Talk About It*, was certified gold for sales in excess of 500,000 copies on April 15, 2008.

Mullen established a mentor group for girls called "The Baby Girls Club". She and her husband, David Mullen, are youth leaders in their local church, tutor inner-city youth, and participate in Kids Across America summer camp for inner city youth. Mullen is also active with the International Needs Network Ghana, an organization that works to free Trokosi slaves in Ghana.

On January 1, 2011, it was announced that Nicole was being inducted into the Christian Music Hall of Fame. She will be formally inducted into the Hall of Fame on November 5, 2011.

## **Africa Report #18, Blantyre, Malawi, Friday February 25, 2011**

Thursday the number increased to about 210. Today the number was about 225. People are sitting everywhere, even on the floor. I hardly had room to move when teaching. We had our first demonstration, and the spirit fell on the woman. She began weeping profusely and crying out to God for freedom. I prayed for her for a few minutes, and the Lord delivered her very quickly. Many of the crowd was crying. Some were kneeling on the floor. The Holy Spirit was there in abundance.

Today Friday, we had the second demonstration in the morning. It went very well. The woman wept for perhaps 30 minutes. Many people in the congregation were crying and wailing. The Holy Spirit was heavy. We then prayed freedom from darkness for all 225 who were there. It was a marvelous time. The Holy Spirit fell in even greater measure. Afterward, people were dancing, singing and praising the Lord for 40 minutes. The building could hardly contain the joy and happiness of all those that had been set free. Many mothers with babies on their backs were dancing. I don't know how the little ones survived. It was a most wonderful time in the Lord.

Later we prayed for those who had pain, and the Lord healed all except one. This seminar experience was one of the top three of all the seminars we have done. God is good.

Tomorrow, Saturday, we will travel to our next seminar town, Zomba, about one hour away.

## **#21 Zomba, Malawi, East Africa Sunday, 2/27/2011**

We arrived in Zomba Saturday afternoon. It is a delightful little town part way up some small mountains. It rains some and the weather is cooler. Fog covers the small mountain behind our hotel. A small stream runs down the mountain about 300 feet from my room. It has several small waterfalls, and I can hear them at night. It is a beautiful place and the people are very friendly and courteous. I have been doing almost all of the driving (left side of the road) and am still getting used to having to share my lane with walkers, bicycles, and hand carts. It is a little dangerous.

I reluctantly taught in the local coordinators church Sunday. As usual, I taught on healing of the spirit. I prayed for the group as a whole to be released, and then prayed for those with pain. Seven stood. All were healed. I prayed for a man with a terrible skin disease, and a woman with epilepsy. Others wanted prayer for wayward husbands, their ministry for Jesus, and their children. It was a very good day.

More in a day or two. Arlin

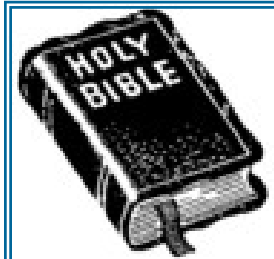

Subject: You must be spreading the light!

Your house was 'invaded' by someone that does not like what you are doing over there. Last week we checked on your house and everything looked fine. I stopped by yesterday and found your refrigerator and oven doors open, the trash can had been tipped over and was scattered on the floor the toaster was knocked off the counter, a bunch of picture frames were knocked over, an empty wooden shelf by the furnace room was on the floor, the furnace room was open and the curtain rod over the windows was knocked off. At first I thought that someone had been looking around your house for something to steal. However, the office and bedroom weren't touched. As I looked around the house, it occurred to me that it looked like someone had thrown a temper tantrum. It was then that I realized it was a spiritual temper tantrum, not a human one. You must be making him very mad!! I grinned and laughed to myself and said a prayer of protection over your house. I just thought you would like to know that you must be doing something right over there. Keep up the good work!! We'll take care of things here at home. God bless, Duane.

## **Africa Report #23, Zomba, Malawi, Africa, Friday March 4, 2011**

I had my 2<sup>nd</sup> African hair cut, in a women's salon from the one guy who worked there. I had one last year when I was in Kenya but this is the first one here this year. I didn't want to go to a men's barber shop for fear I would get an African "buss" cut like most African men wear. It took him a while, but I was satisfied when he was finished.

The lights go out several times a day and evening here. Every room is equipped with a candle and matches. I had a problem with ants as well. So I made them buy me some "Doom" which seems to do the job if sprayed morning and evening.

We are at 7,000 or 8,000 feet here so we get rain almost every day and night.



There were 171 pastors, wives and church leaders on Wednesday the first day of the seminar here. We are in a very large church, and the large space is affecting the intimacy of the group. But they are coming. Thursday we had 217. Two from the Salvation Army came Wednesday. Today 15 came. Word is getting around. Catholics, Baptists, Presbyterians, and Pentecostals all came. Several pastors walked 4 hours to get there. The local coordinator was busy praying salvation to the Catholics outside during the lunch. This is truly a diverse group. They have never had teaching like this before, both content and presentation. In Africa all speakers stand behind a large pulpit on some kind of a stage, far in front of the audience, and shout and scream their presentations. I walk up and down the aisles and touch many of them.

Friday, concluded our seminar in Zomba. We had the second volunteer demonstrations this morning. After the morning break, we prayed for all the pastors. It appeared that all 225 were healed from darkness, i. e. witchcraft, polygamy, family practices, and tribal customs. Afterward the band played for the biggest part of an hour while the congregation hollered and screamed full of new found happiness and joy.

After the prayers for release, the group praised the Lord for a half hour. It was an excellent time in the Lord. The band was excellent. Probably better than any other we have seen. A guitar, two keyboards and a base, and five singers composed the group.

During the teaching on physical healing, I prayed for a young woman that had pain in her feet for 12 years. God healed her. About 75 stood who had pain. I prayed twice, and all but 3 had returned to their seats healed. I called some of those that had been healed to gather around the remaining 3 to pray for them. They were healed. Again, God is good. He healed every one, and hands were only laid on 3.

After the seminar we prayed for people one on one for several hours for family problems, HIV, adulterous husbands, and many other needs.

*Praise be to the Lord for his faithfulness and great power to even deliver his children. Below are the great testimonies of the Lord doings amongst his children.*

**1. A MAN SAW ANGELS IN OUR MIDST**

Mr. B.C. MASONGANO – Sr. Elder of Voice of God Ministries stood to testify that when Professor Epperson was leading the entire of about 230 Pastors and church leaders in attendance the Lord opened his eyes and he saw by the spirit of God angels holding hands like in a circle. He said the same circle was so big and it appeared to be like was a hedge protecting everyone who was with the church. What encouraged him was that it appeared these angels were fighting for us breaking all forms of bondages and hindrance, glory to the Lord.

Pastor Christopher Mhango of Oasis of Love Ministries he said while professor was doing a demonstration with a lady second volunteer when he started commanding forces of witchcraft, rejection and curses to let go the woman ,the Lord opened the named Pastor eyes to see the woman's heart and immediately he saw something like a dark blanket which was covering the same lady's heart and spirit torn in pieces and bright light shined in the Lady's heart and immediately he heard the lady praying thanking God and the said Pastor joined her to praise God for her freedom.

**3. A NURSE HEALED FROM EPILEPSY**

It was a great day for Patricia Malunga a senior nurse who has been suffering with Epilepsy for the past 12 years. Due to the above mentioned sickness Patricia was medically advised not to move alone but with someone in case she falls and always she has had heaviness but ever since the Healing of the Spirit Seminar started she has been coming by herself and the heaviness she has had for the past twelve (12) years just left her today (4<sup>th</sup> March,2011) after going through a prayer led by Epperson of closing the gates. She said God be glorified for delivering my life from this bondage.

**4. A PROPHECY**

It was just after Professor Epperson closed in a word of prayer and instructed the Praise Team to lead the entire seminar participants in thanksgiving to express to God how grateful we are for his grace, mercy and love to forgive and healing us. In 2003 he started going to a Pentecostal church but still he did not know what to do with the witchcraft he inherited many years ago and this has been torturing him for many years till on the 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2011 during the Healing of the Spirit Seminar in Zomba, Malawi, during a prayer session he felt fire burning in his bones and started shaking, crying and there was a lot of movements in his body from his head to his toes and it took him close to 20 minutes and suddenly he saw light shine on his face and immediately peace and lightness came upon him ever since he is delivered and tomorrow Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2011 he will stand in Church to confess so that his deliverance be complete. Glory be to God!

Saturday we drive about 5 hours to our next seminar. More next week.

### **Africa Report #26, Mwanza and Bukoba seminars. March 23. 2011**

After a 10 hour layover in Lilongwe, Malawi, I arrived Mwanza, Tanzania, midmorning Sunday. The one day seminar in Mwanza on Monday went well with 257 pastors and wives. The only problem was many came late even until noon. It apparently is the culture to come late here. There was not time to pray for individuals, so I don't know the testimonies of those that may have been set free by prayer for the group at once.

Yesterday, we traveled by air from Mwanza to Bukoba for a one day seminar. The weather was bad, when we made the 40 minute trip by air across Lake Victoria, but returned to Mwanza because the dirt airport in Bukoba was covered in water. Later the flight was cancelled. We secured another flight on another airline and arrived about 4:00 PM. We had a number of problems with the caterer and the local committee, which eventually ended up costing us about \$500 in extra lunch fees for people who registered who did not show up. They didn't all arrive until after 10:00 am, so we didn't have time to pray for them. I was here 3 years ago, but did not bring books. So I felt the burden to return. Because of the problems, I will not return here in the future. Too many problems.

One husband and wife shared their testimony from 3 years ago with me. I prayed for a tumor in the wife's stomach. She was scheduled for surgery within a couple of weeks. She had been barren for 9 years. The tumor left, she got pregnant and now has a healthy 1 year old daughter. God is good.

We will catch a flight back across the lake at 7:00 am and travel to Shinyanga tomorrow for a seminar on Friday. It is about a 2 hour drive by car.

Africa Report #24, Kasumga, Malawi, Africa, Friday March 11, 2011

This seminar has been one of the best. We thought we had a problem when the location was changed from the town center to a little village about 16 miles away. But it turned out to be a blessing. The first day there were 242, day two, 276 and the final day today 315. Yesterday and today there were over 200 there before 8:00 AM, something unheard of in the 27 previous seminars. There were no cars other than ours, and only about 20 bicycles. The rest walked. Some walked all night to get to the meetings. Some slept in the church on the benches with backs. Most sat during the teaching on little 2x6 benches with no backs.

The group was very hungry and enthusiastic. The teaching was anointed as a result. They almost didn't want to stop for breaks or lunch. As usual we had a demonstration on Tuesday afternoon and another one this morning. One woman testified this morning that yesterday she came to the meeting with Malaria, and was healed as well as set free from a number of spirits of darkness. Another pastor had his deaf left ear opened sitting in his seat with no one praying for him. Today we prayed for all in the group, and all were set free. They danced, sang, and praised the Lord for over 30 minutes afterward. After lunch we prayed for those in pain. Over 100 stood. After 3 prayers, all of them had returned to their seats with their pain healed. We prayed for other needs of their body. Many were healed. We could not tell if several we prayed for with HIV were healed or not until they go for a new check. Neither could we tell if a man with skin cancer on his legs and ankles was healed or not. We prayed for one blind person that was not healed. A young girl about age 14 was healed of pain in her stomach from ulcers.

Following the teaching on the Spirit of Poverty, we took a collection for the poor. The spirit of giving fell on us. Many had nothing to give, so they began giving their shoes, cell phones, watches, shawls, coats etc. It was amazing. There was a pile of over 3 dozen shoes.

We prayed individually for over 40 who remained after the close of the seminar. Some came with HIV. Others had various problems and concerns. Many were touched with the spirit during prayer and began to weep and cry out. Several fell to the floor. The Spirit was very powerful upon them.

## **Africa Report #25, Mzuzu, Malawi, March 19, 2011**

Yesterday we had a little scrape with the car. A cycle rider was following too close, and when we slowed quickly to turn he tried to pass on our right so as not to hit the rear of the car, and sideswiped our right front fender. He and his bike landed in the ditch. While it was clearly his fault, in order not to have to put up with a lengthy police investigation which might have required us to stay several days longer than we intended, I paid \$200 to have his bike repaired. Now I must deal with the car owner about the damage to the right front fender of his car. The situation could have been much more serious. The bike rider was not injured except for a couple of scratches on his arm. If he had hit the rear of the car, he would have been thrown over the car and landed on the pavement with serious results. I have learned that sometimes the Lord does not protect you 100% from all problems, but when they do come, He limits the extent of the damage so that usually they can be settled with money, which is the easiest problems for Him to resolve. God is good.

I am getting very tired of the diet of either tough beef and rice, or road runner chicken and rice or French fries. This evening I just stopped by the local grocery and purchased a can of pork and beans, and ate half of it for supper. It was a little challenge to get it open, but it wasn't too bad. Breakfast is always the same. Eggs, link sausage, potatoes in some form, and baked beans. I am getting a little tired of that also, but I will survive.

Today we had 162. This was a little short of our planned 200, but we closed registration at 11:00 today and will not take late comers tomorrow. This is a responsive group with about 85 pastors, bishops, and apostles and their wives. An email demanding prepayment today for our venue in Burundi along with full payment for all meals there, may result in our having to cancel the seminar planned for Bujumbura, Burundi April 11-13. We will see if a replacement location can be located.

Friday, March 18, we completed our seminar in Mzuzu with about 180. Yesterday was mostly teaching. Today we prayed for the pastors to be set free. Because of the strong anointing over the group, it only took about 30 minutes when it usually takes over an hour. One pastor came in this morning telling us that he had been set free over night by reading the book and praying. During our prayer for one of the demonstrations, a wife of a pastor saw a cross come down from heaven dripping with blood to cover those that were praying for the person. There were many testimonies of God's goodness and mercy as many shared how they had been released. Another had a spiritual dream. There were several prophetic gifts offered. It has been one of the most anointed seminars I have been involved with. The intensity seems to be increasing.

During the teaching and prayer on physical healing, all those that stood with pain were healed except one. I am sure she was not healed because of open gates of vanity, self pity, control, and perhaps a spirit of Jezebel. I didn't have the heart to tell her why she did not receive healing with all the rest.

It was a very good day. God is good. Tomorrow, we leave at 7:00 am for a 5 hour drive back to Lilongwe. Billie will drive on to his home in Lusaka, Zambia, another 7 hours, where his wife is due with their fourth child next week. I will have a 10 hour wait for my plane departure at 11:35 PM and arrive Nairobi 5:20 AM.; Then catch another plane for Mwanza, Tanzania at 8:25am Our next one day seminar will be on Monday. We will report again to you after that.

## Africa Report #27 Shinyanga, Tanzania Friday, March 25, 2011

We are traveling in Bishop Isaya's Toyota 4x4. It is diesel and apparently has a fuel injection pump that is not working properly. What normally would be a 2 hour trip required almost 4 hours, as we had to drive the last 1.5 hours here at about 25 miles per hour with much smoke billowing out the back. It pumped an extra quart of fuel into the oil pan during the trip. A mechanic is coming from Mwanza on Saturday morning to try to fix it. It seems we have more than our share of problems with transportation.

There were 147 pastors, wives and church leaders here today. We used the same church as when I was here 3 years ago. The group was a little stiff, and I had some trouble getting them to respond. The primary reason I returned here was to give them books, which they did not receive 3 years ago. One day seminars with a translator are very difficult. Much material has to be left out. I probably will not do another one day in Africa. We prayed for the entire group and the Lord again delivered them all. We prayed then for those with physical pain, and again the Lord healed all of them without hands being laid on them except two. We prayed for them, and they were healed. Praise God! Several testimonies were shared, some from the seminar 3 years ago.

God is good.

Saturday, assuming Isaya gets his car fixed we will travel 4 hours to Tabora for a 3 day seminar beginning Tuesday. If he does not get his car fixed, I will take the bus by myself.

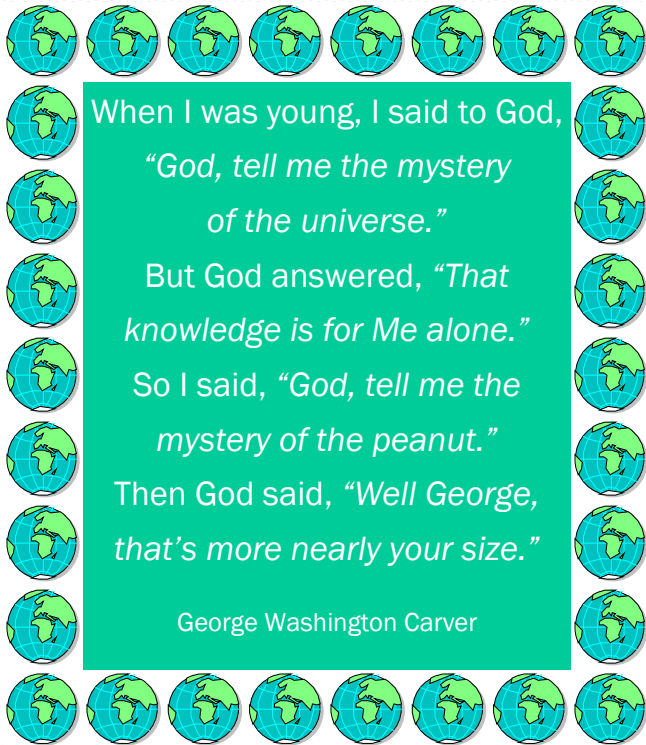

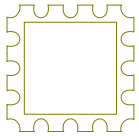
