Acknowledge Him in all of your ways!

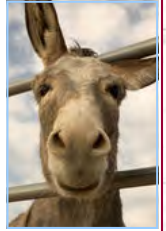

Almost all Christians look on salvation in terms of fire insurance, simply escaping an eternal torment. For many that is the end of the matter. For many, salvation (being born again), includes the prospect of blessing, health, healing, financial stability, wealth, resolution to problems, dreams, visions, signs, miracles, and many other such things.

The purpose of Christ and Christianity is not blessing and miracle and healing and ritual and being 'saved'. What Christianity is about is willingly living the Godly life. We are created by God to live with God and to give Him pleasure (Revelation 4:11). Because of "the Fall", we are inclined to be motivated by our own self-interest, which leads us to do that which is evil, to make decisions based on self-interest and personal inclinations, to do that which is beneficial to us. I pursue those things which are profitable to me, promote my well-being, and give me pleasure. And I spend much of my life learning to do this, disregarding the will of God and at the expense of other people.

True Christianity is about transformation, being changed from the kind of person that I am into a new kind of person altogether. A couple of years ago Bob Slasor brought a 'word' to C.C.M. which told us, among other things, that the blessings that we experience are not the end of the matter, but that the purpose of the blessing is that we should be transformed. Paul said that if we live in Christ we are 'new creatures' (2 Corinthians 5:17). John tells us that if we believe in Jesus, He gives us the power (authority, right) to 'become the sons of God' (John 1:12). And Jesus said that we must be born again (John 3:3-6). This means being changed from one state to another (Mosiah 11:188). This change of state is as true as stepping across the line from the United States in to Canada. It is an entirely different domain.

We are reborn so that we can start all over again. We need to unlearn all that we have previously been accustomed to, and start living, thinking, and speaking in the manner approved of by God. True rebirth begins with a most fundamental change in our nature: we find that we have no more inclination to do evil (Mosiah 3:1-3). Instead we find that we want to do only what is good and right. In this new state, having been born all over again, we are now children, as Jesus said we must become (3 Nephi 5:39-40). As children we are innocent (Doctrine & Covenants 90:6b) and we are malleable in the hands of God (Mosiah 1:120). This is so true that John can say that those who are born of God do not continue in sin (1 John 3:9).

Now, anyone who says that Christians don't sin after being reborn has never known a Christian. We still live in flesh and sin dwells in our members (Romans 7:19, 25), and struggle ensues thereby. But we have ability to continually deliver ourselves into His hands (Romans 6:12-14), repenting if we need to (1 John 1:8-9), maintaining that innocence.

We are reborn and made to be new creatures so that we can start all over again and get it right. And we are to be agents by which His will is "done on earth, as it is done in Heaven". We are to do that by seeking Him and His will, allowing Him to operate within us (Galatians 2:20), embracing the principle of love (Luke 10:28; 6:27; John 13:34).

I walked to the cashier smiling from ear to ear, and said to her, "Here are the other 12. We can cancel the order now." She was so blown away! She kept saying, "No! This can't be! We don't have any!" Kathy and I laughed and said, "Well, you don't now!" God really wanted the women at our retreat to have these books. After this experience, we decided that the theme for the retreat would be **GRACE AND FORGIVENESS**.

"I thank you, Father God, for the rich testimony of your faithfulness toward me. After dealing with the intense part of Jim's horseback riding accident, 8 days in the hospital healing from a collapsed lung and several broken and crushed ribs resulting in extremely intense pain and inability to breathe deeply, Jim was sent home to continue his recovery. Finally returning to some normalcy in journaling and bible study, you brought me to a section in Isaiah, particularly Isaiah 52:12 where the scripture says, *"But you will not leave in haste or go in flight; for the LORD will go before you, the God of Israel will be your rear guard."* I looked rear guard up in the dictionary and found out that it was a separate army that stayed behind the main army that did battle with the enemy and basically protected the back of the army from the enemy. And the commentary said, *"basically it means God has your back."* It was a comfort to learn that because that following Sunday (the second week we were home from the hospital) when I was on the way to church I got a call from Jim saying, *"Gabriel (our eldest son who was hunting alone) has been hurt bad. Go to Phelps County Hospital right away."* I didn't want to go and I didn't want to deal with another injury of my loved ones. I called Sandy from church and left a message on her cell phone that I wouldn't be going and what had happened and asked everyone to pray for us. Then I called my Texas CCM friend, Kathy Brinsdon, asking for prayers and she said, *"Don't worry, Kathy, God's got your back."* It immediately brought to my mind the lesson You, my God had instilled in my heart earlier that very week and I knew You were telling me things would be okay. When I got off the phone, I simply replied to God, *"I trust you, Father"* and off I went.

Father, you are my hero and you are ever faithful. Knowing our finances have been hit very hard I can only contribute the pizza meal to having dinner on Jesus on my way to the CCM Leadership retreat. Yes, I stopped at a Casey's gas station and was going to buy two pieces of pizza for my supper but they only had one sausage pizza that had been warmed up for a considerable amount of time so the lady said to just take it if you want it. It's yours for free. (They were cleaning them out and pitching the ones that were in the warmer.) So, dinner was on You. You bless us so much with the little things and often I know we are simply unaware of those little blessings. But I am aware of this one and I know You will help us get through this storm and I thank You that Jim is getting a little better each and every day and I trust you that Gabriel's infection in his leg will heal. "

For those of you who would like to know more about Arlin Epperson's ministry in Africa, we have his 'logs' that he is sending back to this country. We hope that these will bless and encourage you in your own walk with our Lord Jesus.

Africa Report 1, January 20, 2011, Dubai

It will be 3 more weeks before I begin ministering in Africa, but I thought you might be interested in hearing reports of what God is doing in some of the meetings I am involved with now.

I arrived Dubai with no problems at 4:55 AM Tuesday after about 30 hours and 4 flights. Dubai is a wonderful city, with one of the lowest crime rates of any major city in the world. The architecture of the high rise buildings is stunning. There is much money here, and more BMW's per block than anywhere I have ever been. There is no trash anywhere, and I have yet to see a slum area here. This is truly a composite mixture of people from every nation on earth. Last evening was the first meeting of the *School of Healing and Impartation* here in Dubai.

There were about 1500 people crammed into a hotel meeting room. Many were standing or seated on the floor. There were over 150 who had flown in from faraway places such as Canada, US, Australia, England, Ireland, South Africa. They are truly a spiritually hungry group. Randy Clark and Bill Johnson both spoke. Bill is always awesome in his preaching with new found truths coming from him in almost every sentence. If you have not heard him, you need to order a CD. I could not take notes fast enough.

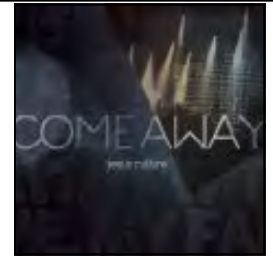
Randy showed a video of a man who had metal in his back who was healed. As a result of the video, several people in the audience were healed of limitations and pain caused by metal or screws in their bodies. Randy gave several words of knowledge of some with pain in the right lower hip and thigh. Six stood to report healing, from as much as 16, years of pain. One who had a hip replacement lost his limp. Randy called for testimonies. Several reported healing during praise and worship time. Bill said a healing spirit was present and called for all those who had missing knee cartridges or ruptured back disks to stand. Over twenty reported healing. The healings were too numerous to count. At the end of the evening over 100 people stood to report healing during the evening with no one laying hands on them. And this was the first night, when it is always more difficult, as the teaching and testimonies have not raised faith to the level that is expected by the end of the school. *God is good.*

"The light of the eyes rejoices the heart.

Good news gives health to the bones." — Proverbs 15:30



Laughter in regular daily doses can do the heart good. It has been scientifically proven, but better than that, God Himself tells us to laugh. Hmm! You would think almost that He knew that when He created us. *"Then our mouth was filled with laughter, and our tongues with singing. Then they said among the nations 'The Lord has done great things for them.'" (Psalm 126:2)* All right! That's what I'm talkin' about!

So, not only is laughter a good thing for health, but singing too. Not just any singing, but praises to our King! *"And the ransomed of the Lord shall return, and come to Zion with singing. With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away."* (Isaiah 35:10) Praise God! He's got it all covered for us. Praise Him in all things! Celebrate and have joy in His presence! HE can change our sorrow into gladness. WOW! What an awesome God!

Africa Report 3, 1/23/2011 Kathmandu, Nepal Sorry for not reporting earlier, but the fee here for Wi-Fi is \$14.00 per day, and we are restricted from wandering about the neighborhood. So I saved my money and elected to buy one day beginning at midnight Monday evening.

I arrived Kathmandu Saturday afternoon in preparation for being a part of the 40 member team that will minister to pastors and leaders at their conference here. In the last 7 days, I have been in and out of 10 airports and carried on all my luggage to insure it was not lost. The Lord has given me favor with customs and passport personnel, as I have had to obtain visas at the border of two countries, and I failed to bring photos. Notwithstanding that you may wish a bit of the flavor and experiences of my travels, I will keep the reports of the travels short, as I do not intend for this to be a "blog" of my travel experiences, but a report of what God is going in the locations where I am.

Kathmandu is the largest city in Nepal with about 4 million people with 250,000 of them owning motor bikes. If I die here it will be because I am struck by motor cycle coming out of a small side street that "beep beep's" me before it strikes me. While Dubai represented extreme wealth, the parts of Kathmandu I traveled through to get to our hotel represented extreme poverty, similar to many parts of Africa with very narrow streets. An additional problem here is the current temperature which is about 10 degrees centigrade, which for westerners is about 50 degrees. Many here have to live in little shacks with cardboard sides and a tin roof. Outside of hotels, none of the buildings are heated. In our church meeting place we sat today from 9:00 A.M. until about 8:00 PM in 50 degrees. I heard about it ahead of time so I brought my long johns, and didn't fair too badly. All of the locals sit on the floor cross legged all day long.

Since part of the team had weather problems flying in, a majority did not arrive until 7:30 PM on Sunday evening, so we missed out on Sunday's conference activities, but today made up for it.

There were about 500 pastors and leaders at the meeting. Randy spoke 3 times today, and Tom Jones once. It took a while for the group to loosen up. At the end of the first session, the Holy Spirit fell, and Randy asked those that could feel the presence of the Holy Spirit on their bodies to stand. About three fourths of those there stood, beginning on the left with the men, and moving across the audience to the right in a wave. The women's side was almost 100%. During the last session, each of the team members gave a word of knowledge about some specific health problem the Lord wanted to heal. After Randy prayed for the group, about 250 stood to indicated they had received healing during Randy's prayer. After that we began to pray for individuals. I must have prayed for 10 or 12, I don't remember. Two had back pain; one large woman had back pain and pain in both knees. Several had pain in their ribs. One young teen age girl had pain in her head and was dizzy part of the time, probably from residue from her activities as a Hindu, or worshipping at one of the many Hindu statues or shrines in the area. One woman had a collapsed right lung and had breathing problems. She said she could feel the lung being restored, and her breathing got instantly better. I can't remember all the others, all I know is that each one reported that they were healed and all of the pain had left. It was a wonderful night.

During the team meeting after dinner this evening, we counted 160 people received healing as we prayed for them individually. As part of our team meeting, we heard a testimony from an American missionary working in Nepal that officially died for over 30 minutes, and was prayed back to life. There have been over 400 official, substantiated reports of people in Mozambique being raised from the dead. This is where Heidi Baker works.

Team members are taking one hour periods each night to intercede for this conference and the one that follows later in the week in India. I have the 1:00 AM until 2:00 AM time slot this evening. I expect to see even greater things tomorrow. *God is good.*

African Report # 4 1-25-2011. Tuesday, Kathmandu, Nepal

Another wonder day in the Lord. There were almost 80 healings noted today by team members. There were over 250 that said they were healed when Randy Clark prayed from the front. Sometimes it seems more effective to pray for them as a group, and one on one. I had a touch case that wasn't healed. A woman had broken her leg, and didn't have money to get it set, so there were two metal shafts one on each side of her leg, with horizontal pins extending from the shafts horizontal into the bone to keep it in temporary place. It didn't look very good. But we remember what the Lord does, not what he doesn't do else we would become overly discouraged and not continue. Another young woman complained of pain in her side and head. We prayed and nothing happened. I felt to ask her how long she had been a Christian. She said about 6 months. I asked her when the pain began, she said about 6 months ago. I asked her if she had been a Hindu. She said yes. When Hindu's convert, they bring a lot of spiritual baggage with them. They worship many gods, have been to Buddhist temples, and participated in Hindu activities, all of which give place for the darkness to enter. Once she repented and renounced these things, she fell to the floor and was resting in the spirit for over 30 minutes. We travel tomorrow to north India, which includes a 5 hour bus ride. So it may be a day or two before I get a change to report again. *God is good.*

African Report #5, 1-27-2011 Chandigarh, India

We began our 3 day conference today with about 350 pastors and leaders. Chandigarh is a beautiful town in north India. It was well planned with much greenery. It gets a lot of tourists, and I have yet to see the slum areas and narrow roads of Delhi, and Kathmandu.

I forgot to fill you in on some of the miracles of the earlier two days. They made me the statistician for the group so I have recorded the following numbers for our group for the previous 3 days. Blind eyes opened 6, deaf ears open 15, tumors gone 4, and one lame person walked. We are getting to expect these as common place. Below is a report of one woman I prayed for. A woman came forward complaining of pain in her lower spine, in her heart and in both knees, to the point she could hardly walk. I prayed for her heart area first, and after a short prayer, she said the pain was gone. I then prayed for her lower spine and after a few moments she could bend over which she could not do before. I then prayed for her knees. After the first prayer, she felt considerable improvement. After the 2nd prayer, the pain was completely gone, and she could walk up and down the steps in the meeting area with no problem. *God is good.*

6 African report Chandigarh, India Friday evening.

We just completed a 2nd day of the conference with about 450. I am looking at the stat sheet report for today. Team members prayed for 46 who were healed. Over 90 ended up on the floor resting in the spirit as a result of laying on of hands for impartation and transfer of spiritual gifts of healing. 257 said they were healed by prayers from the front by Randy Clark with no one touching or praying individually for them. One blind person received their sight. 3 people had deafness, one from birth, and they all received their hearing. I prayed for a lady with a pancreas problem, which she felt was healed. She stood in for her daughter who had asthma and we think the daughter was healed as well. One of our team was asked by a daughter at the meeting to pray for a mother over the phone for asthma. The mother was praising God for her healing, and then according to an aunt with her, she fell out on the floor at home under the influence of the Holy Spirit. Many were healed of pain, some of which they had carried for over 15 years. When Randy asked all those who received healing today to stand and wave their arms, and over half of the 450 stood. There are almost too many to count. *God is good.* There are less than 5% Christians in northern India where we are. Some one prophesized that there would be a flood of revival come from the north into this part of India. They are hungry. *Good is good.*

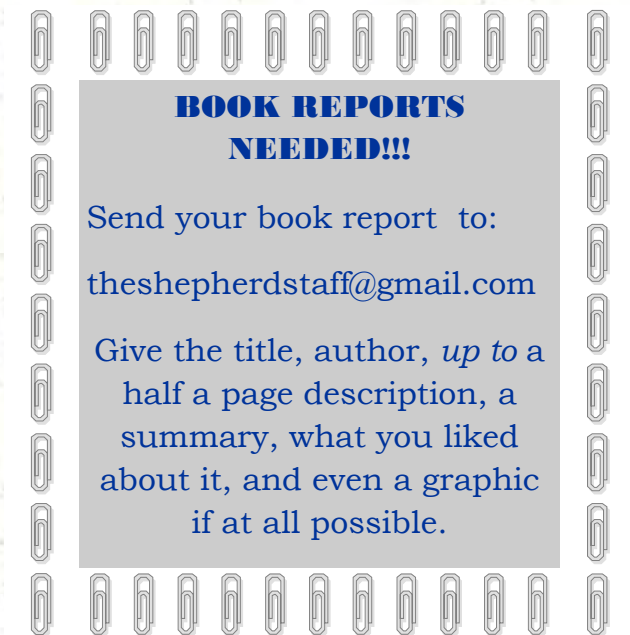

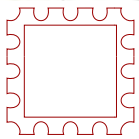
