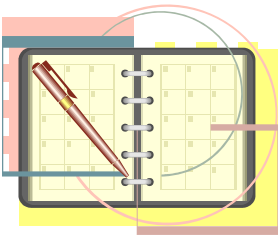

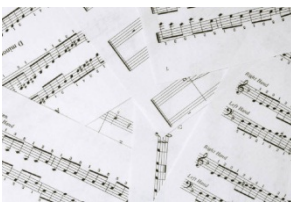


## DON'T MISS THESE TWO EVENTS!
