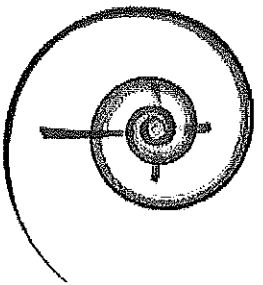

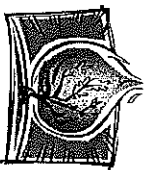

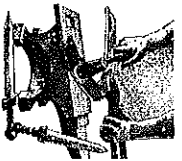
Throughout the Temple you will find examples of the "fire" we experience when we encounter the Holy Spirit.

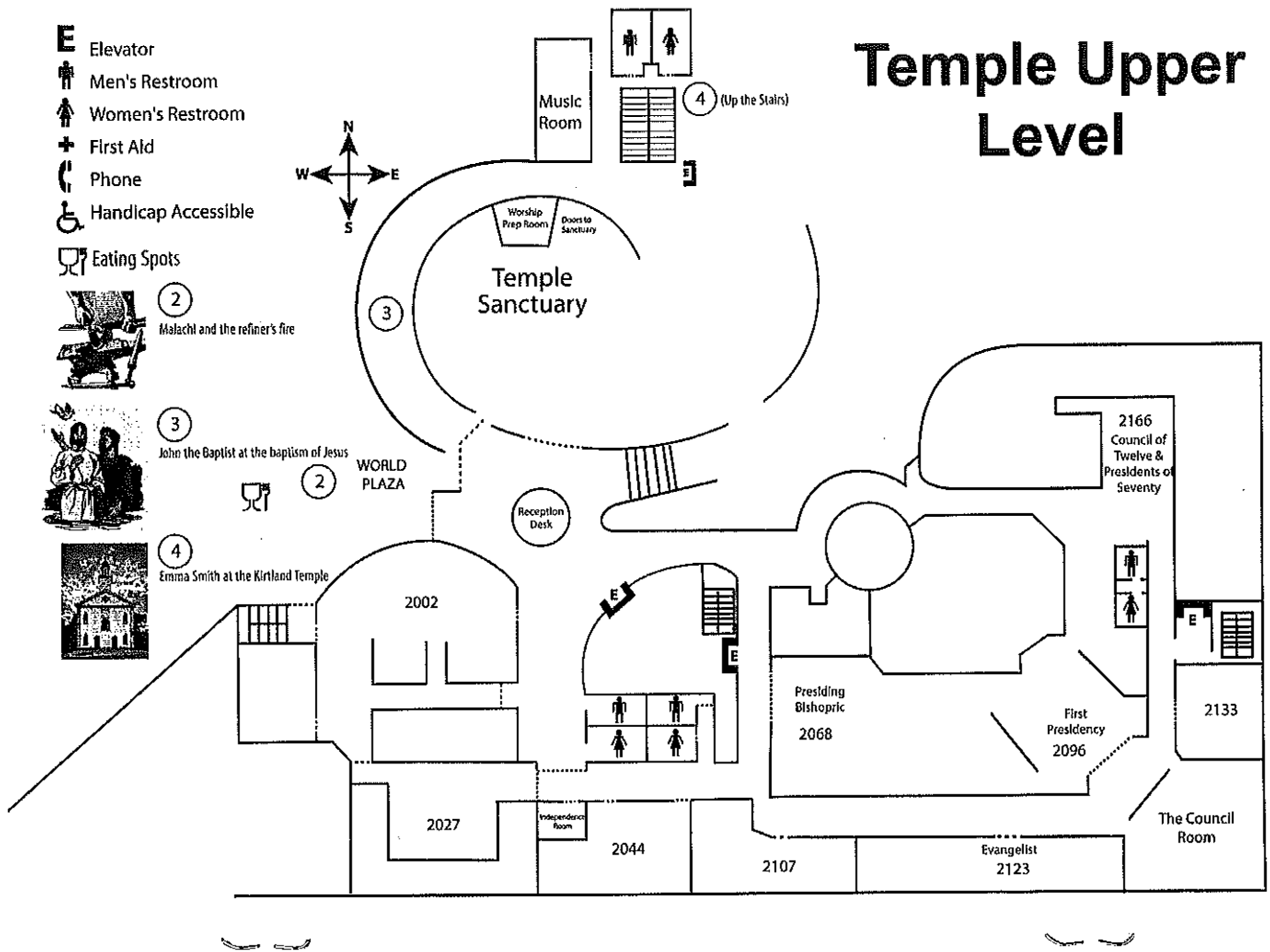

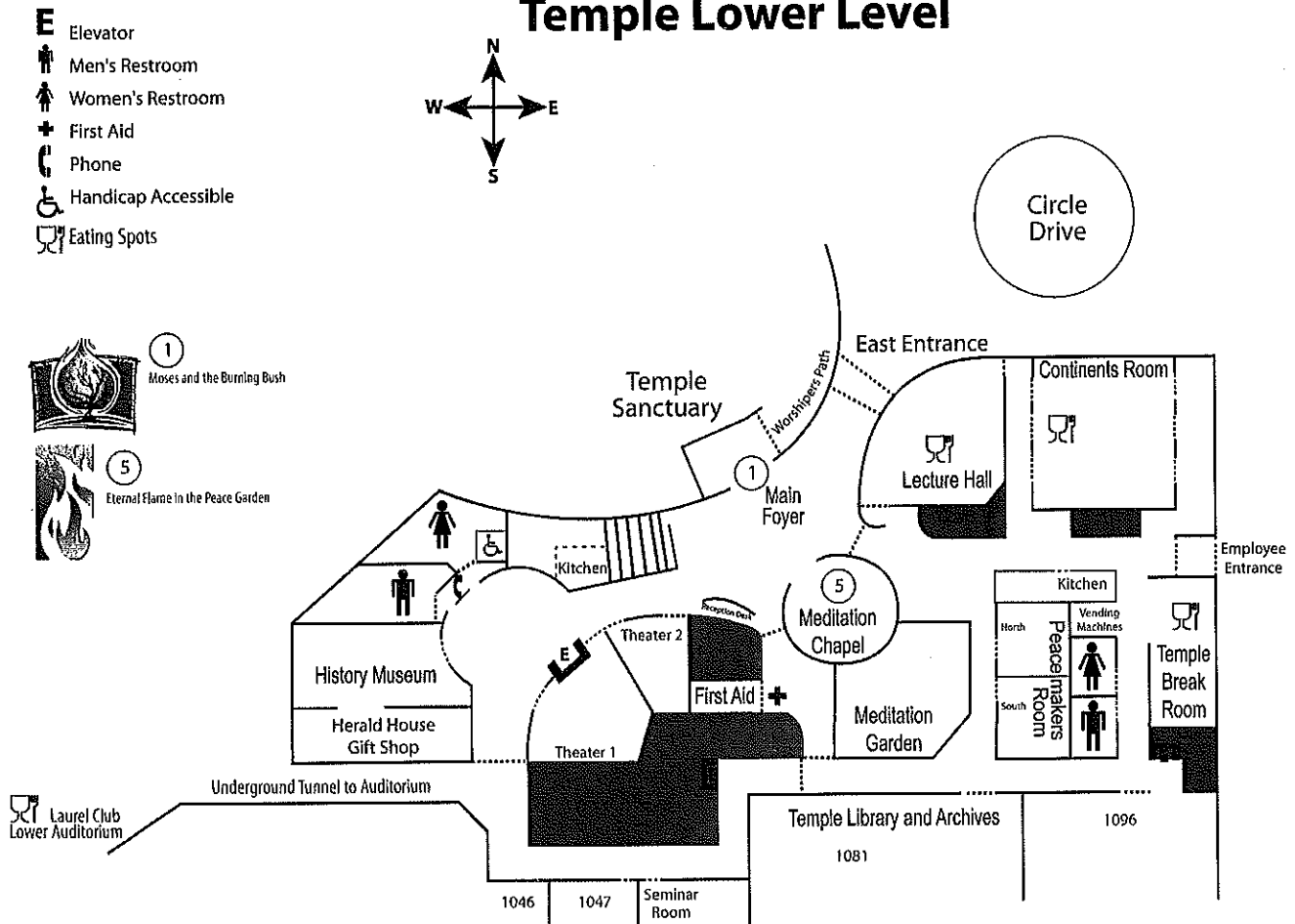
