

## **Vulnerable to Grace**

### **Introduction**

“Do not turn away in pride, fear, or guilt from the One who seeks only the best for you and your loved ones. Come before your Eternal Creator with open minds and hearts and discover the blessings of the gospel anew. Be vulnerable to divine grace” (Doctrine and Covenants 163:10b). This brief passage provides the foundational scripture for the theme development of Reunion 2009. Several other passages are also used to develop daily themes, creating a model of the important aspects of living out discipleship.

It is hoped that in using several of these suggested passages for reunion instruction and worship we can live in community during the reunion experience and also be changed as we return to our home communities—changed in such a way that we will live out the expression of Christ’s involvement in our lives with others.

### **General Thoughts about Theme Scriptures**

Theme scriptures would set daily themes for reunion programming. This programming would include (but not be limited to) worship helps, fellowship/prayer meeting helps, campfire helps, a baptismal service, and class materials for children and youth.

### **How to Use Reunion Helps**

The reunion helps for this year are designed with flexibility in mind. Seven modules are presented for your use on seven different days. They are in no particular order and can be utilized where they would best fit your own specific reunion program. In other words, on your first day you might find that Theme 5 best fits your plans. We hope the added freedom in this plan is a blessing to you as you prepare the reunion experience for your campers.
