Summary of Position	<p>The Kirtland Temple Spiritual Formation Support Minister will work with Spiritual Formation Ministries and Historic Sites to provide meaningful encounters between spiritual formation and history. This volunteer position will serve on both the Kirtland Temple Visitor and Spiritual Formation Center Team, as well as the Spiritual Formation Team; and in this role will support Historic Sites and Spiritual Formation Ministries as needed through onsite support at the Kirtland Temple and with Spiritual Formation projects and events. The position reports to Community of Christ’s Spiritual Formation Team Lead, but will be responsible to the Kirtland Temple Visitor and Spiritual Formation Center team lead on matters involving historical interpretation and site operation.</p>
Key Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coordinate with and host groups who are planning a spiritual retreat at the Kirtland Temple • Offer pastoral care and spiritual growth opportunities for Kirtland Temple visitors, staff, volunteers, and summer interns • Collaborate with Historic Sites to integrate spiritual formation into the daily operations of the Kirtland Temple Historic Site, such as offering Prayers for Peace in the temple, and leading ‘Reflect & Explore’ tours of the temple • Participate in worship service planning and ministry held in the Kirtland Temple • Support Spiritual Formation Ministries events and trainings at the Spiritual Formation Center • Support Spiritual Formation Ministries projects and resources • Assist as able, especially during peak visitor season, Historic Site
